# How to Measure

## Method 1 : USING AN EXISTING RING



- Choose a ring that already fits your finger well.
- Measure the inner diameter of the ring in millimeters (mm).
- Use the measurement given below to match the size of your ring to the closest Tanishq size in mm.

## Method 2 : THE HANDS-ON APPROACH





- Get a measuring tape, string or strip of paper.
- Wrap it around the finger you'll wear your ring on.
- Using a pen or marker, mark where the ends meet.

- Lay your string or paper strip on a flat surface and use a ruler to measure the length in millimeters (mm).  
**This is the circumference of your ring.**
- Use the chart given below to map this circumference to the diameter. The mapped diameter is your ring size. Use it to buy your chosen ring online at Tanishq.

### FOR BEST RESULTS

- Measure during the end of the day, as your finger may be at its largest.
